Flunstellas are FLocks, CLUsters and ConSTELLAtions of ideas, emotions and memories that have been disembodied from individuals and so float through social spaces.

This constellation of Flunstellas was created by young people from year 7 and 8 of Weatherhead High School in Wallasey. The group worked with artist Neil Winterburn to define and design different breeds of Flunstellas. They composed this constellation using a mixture of programming, hands on making and movement based activities.

Charlie refused to participate in the lesson and stormed out of the class when her teacher pushed her to get her involved. This Flunstella constellation, created by the girls, might help to explain why...
